

**CITY SERVICES COMMITTEE MEETING  
MINUTES FROM APRIL 5, 2011  
HELD AT CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS**

Others Present: City Manager Ron Dunt, Mayor Diane Weldin, PWD Doug Tarr, City Attorney Mike Cross, Chief Ray Beltran.

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m.

The committee reviewed a proposed amended snow removal ordinance submitted by City Attorney Mike Cross. Cross provided some history, explaining some of the issues experienced by enforcement of the current ordinance and recommended changing the language of the ordinance to state that the snow ordinance would automatically go into effect at the start of any snowfall. Chief Beltran agreed with the suggested changes to the ordinance. The committee discussed the proposal and will recommend those changes to the full Council in the future.

The committee then reviewed and discussed a letter received from Mike Cross relative to the City's animal ordinances. The consensus of the committee is to raise fines associated with ordinance violations. The City Attorney will take the information from the committee and make the appropriate amendments to the ordinances, providing the committee with a proposed document in the future for consideration.

The committee reviewed a handout from Doug Tarr with a proposed fee schedule for the new aquatic center. Tarr explained that the proposed fees were a starting point and were previously utilized for an anticipated expenditure and revenue report for the CAT grant application. The consensus of the committee was to keep the rate structure the same as it was in 2010 with some minor changes. The minor changes included general admission for adults going to \$3.00 from \$2.50, general admission for youth going to \$2.00 from \$1.50 and lowering water aerobics (without season pass) to \$3.00 from \$4.00. Other considerations will be given to caregivers and caregiver group rates, as well as adjustments on the punch cards to reflect discounts on the general admission changes. Staff will take the information from the committee and present it at a future Council meeting for full Council consideration for approval.
