

Hampton Recycles

Please contact your individual private waste hauler for instructions and pick up times. The City of Hampton requires twice-per-month collection of recyclables.

The following waste haulers are licensed to service the City of Hampton:

Glass: Clear and colored container glass will be accepted. Glass items must be clean with lids removed. (Ceramics, Pyrex, window glass, drinking glasses, mirror glass and light bulbs will not be accepted. Containers that may have contained any type of hazardous chemicals will not be accepted.)

Plastics: ALL PLASTIC ITEMS MUST HAVE THE RECYCLING LOGO embossed on it to be accepted. Plastic items must be clean and have lids removed. (Plastic bags, Styrofoam and toys will not be accepted. Containers that may have contained any type of hazardous chemicals will not be accepted.)

Metal: Aluminum cans, copper, brass and tin will be accepted. Items must be rinsed and preferably flattened with labels removed. (Pots and pans will not be accepted.)

Cardboard: Must be clean and flattened. (No pizza boxes accepted.)

Cereal Boxes & Boxboard: Waxed paper must be removed and boxes must be flattened.

Hampton Compost & Brush Site 1399 Olive Avenue

The City of Hampton has a compost and brush site located north of Highway 3 along Olive Avenue on the west edge of town. This site is open seasonally (closed during winter months). The site is only open to the public during posted hours and is monitored by a gate attendant. The site will be closed in the event of rainy weather, excessively muddy conditions or temperatures below 34 degrees.

Acceptable Items: Leaves, grass clippings, weeds, garden waste, branches.

Unacceptable Items: Plastic bags, trash, garbage, processed foods, lumber, metal, plastic, glass.

Violations for disposing of unacceptable items are subject to fines.

Franklin Rural Recycling Program

Participants from Franklin County and the City of Hampton are urged to take their recyclables to the recycling containers, located west of the railroad track just inside the entrance to the fairgrounds. Recyclables should be taken in an open container (not plastic bags). The containers at the recycling location can handle all your recycling needs. The west container is for all cardboard products and the east container is for all paper products. The south end of this container is for paper products and the north end is for plastic, tin and glass.

Paper Products: Newspaper, magazines, office paper, shredded paper, colored paper and brown paper bags will be accepted.

Glass: Clear and colored container glass will be accepted. Glass items must be clean with lids removed. (Ceramics, Pyrex, window glass, drinking glasses, mirror glass and light bulbs will not be accepted. Containers that may have contained any type of hazardous chemicals will not be accepted.)

Plastics: ALL PLASTIC ITEMS MUST HAVE THE RECYCLING LOGO embossed on it to be accepted. Plastic items must be clean and have lids removed. (Plastic bags, Styrofoam and toys will not be accepted. Containers that may have contained any type of hazardous chemicals will not be accepted.)

Metal: Items must be rinsed and preferably flattened with labels removed. Aluminum cans, copper, brass and tin will be accepted. (Pots and pans will not be accepted.)

Cardboard & Paper Products: Must be clean and dry. (No pizza boxes accepted.) Corrugated cardboard must be separated and flattened.

Rejected Items:

Wood: All wood products.

Paper: Soiled or wet paper, used paper towels, used paper plates carbon paper.

Cardboard: Wet cardboard, waxed paper and waxed covered boxes.

Other: Aerosol cans , rubber products, Styrofoam containers, photographic film.
