



LAWN CARE REQUIREMENTS:

It is the responsibility of property owners to maintain proper length of grass and weeds on their property (**not to exceed six inches in residential zones**). All properties, including occupied, vacant, residential, commercial, and vacant lots are subject to property maintenance standards.

Compliance is monitored by the City and when non-compliance is observed, a Notice to Abate Nuisance is mailed to property owners and tenants, with a compliance deadline of five days after the date of Notice. If said property is found non-compliant after the deadline, the City will direct a bidding contractor or city staff to abate the nuisance, billing the property owner for the contractor expense, plus 35% administrative costs. The City will monitor compliance on a weekly basis. Property owners with repeated non-compliance are subject to municipal infraction for court action with fine.

Climate conditions in this area typically require lawns to be mowed and trimmed at least once a week to maintain City Code standards. Make arrangements now for hiring private lawn care services, if you need assistance with maintaining your property. Private services will likely cost less than bids submitted to the City and its additional administrative costs.
