BOOK RESERVATIONS FOR HARRIMAN PARK

Harriman Park Shelters may be reserved up to six months in advance, beginning the first business day of the month as listed below:

July reservation - January
August reservation - February
September reservation - March
October reservation - April
November reservation - May
December reservation - June
January reservation - July
February reservation - August
March reservation - September
April reservation - October
May reservation - November
June reservation - December



Locked restroom facilities are located in Shelter #6 and are the only public restrooms in the park. Shelter Deposit must be paid in advance to acquire a restroom key at City Hall. Key may be picked up on the day of the reservation or the Friday prior to weekend reservations.

Reservations cannot be secured by phone.

Shelter Reservations require a signed rental agreement and payment of fees.

RATES

Four-Season Shelter #6 - \$200.00

(Includes \$200.00 Deposit, \$100.00 of this amount may be refunded after return of key and inspection)

Shelters #1-5 & 7 - \$100.00

(Includes \$100.00 Deposit, \$50.00 of this amount may be refunded after return of key and inspection)

Deposits refundable upon satisfactory inspection of facilities by City Staff & prompt return of shelter keys to City Hall.

RESERVATION GUIDELINES

Deposit Refund will be mailed to the reserving party no later than the day following the next City Council Regular Session (2nd & 4th Tuesdays), if City inspection for cleanup/inventory/damages is favorable and keys are returned to City Hall or the Police Dept. by the morning following the reservation date.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Cancellations must be reported to City Hall at least one week prior to the date reserved in order to receive full refund of fees.

SHELTER KEYS

Facility Keys may be picked up at City Hall on the day of your reservation. Saturday & Sunday bookings may pick up keys prior to 5:00 p.m. on the business day before the weekend. (Customers who live outside the community should contact City Hall to make other arrangements for acquiring keys after hours.)

Keys must be returned to City Hall (payment drop after hours) or Police Dept. by the morning following the reservation to be in compliance with deposit refund policy.

PARK CURFEW: Hampton parks close at 10:30 p.m.

ALCOHOL: State regulations enforced regarding legal possession, supplying and intoxication.

NO KEGS allowed.

CLEANING & CLOSING REQUIREMENTS:

Detailed list of cleaning and closing requirements for deposit refund compliance are posted in the parks, enclosed facilities, the City's website, and are also available upon request at City Hall.
