

## **Minutes of June 8, 2026, Hampton City Council Workshop**

The Hampton City Council Workshop was called to order at the Hampton City Council Chambers by Mayor Pro Tem James Davies at 6:00 p.m. The workshop was also offered electronically through Zoom and YouTube. Council members in attendance were Jeanne Fay, Jerre Grefe and Barry Lamos. Mayor Steve Birdsall, council members Bill Holmstrom and Kristin Roode were absent. Also present were City Manager Ron Dunt, Police Chief Mark Morrison, and Public Works Director Doug Tarr. Mayor Pro Tem Davies invited those present to join in the Pledge of Allegiance to the U.S. flag.

Mayor Pro Tem Davies offered time for public comment. There was none.

City Manager Dunt presented a request from Don Swieter Fire Chief of Grant-Lee Township Fire District for mutual aid agreement for fire protection. This agreement is for the cities of Alexander, Coulter, Geneva, Hampton, Hansell, Latimer, Sheffield and Grant-Lee Township, and would be beneficial for all the communities. The agreement will be placed on the next council agenda for approval.

Council Person Grefe discussed littering in city parks, and thanked those that were regularly picking up trash. Grefe asked the council to continue to think of ways to improve the city parks and address the issues of littering.
